Make sure you have: Full uniform (shoes, **black** socks, bibs, ALL parts of jacket, shako, shako wrap, gloves and gauntlets), change of clothes for bus, deodorant, jacket (for evening), snacks, WATER (NO ENERGY DRINKS OR SODA), and instrument (including valve oil, reeds, etc.)

**You will want a sack lunch for Luverne. Bring some cash for concessions and for our Taco Johns run in Brandon.

7:30am – Load Bus

7:50am – Depart for Luverne HS

8:25am – Arrive at Luverne HS

8:30am – Stretch then change into uniform

9:00am – Basics/warmup

9:35am – March to parade route (Some band parents stay and unload the trailer and set up props)

10:35am – Step off at Tri-State Band Festival Parade, Class AA (Parade starts at 9:30am on Luverne Main Street.)

11:00am – Load bus and head back to Luverne HS, eat sack lunch and **HYDRATE (Do not change out of uniforms)**

12:00pm – Set up for field, warm up, rituals

12:35pm – March to stadium

12:45pm – Arrive at West Gate of stadium

1:05pm – Pipestone Marching Arrows perform “Luminous” at Tri-State Band Festival

1:20pm – March back to bus, change into street clothes (hang uniform nicely on hangers!!) and walk back to stadium to watch Class AAA and AAAA perform

2:05pm – Parade Awards (Drum Major at west gate at 1:50)

3:35pm – Field Awards (Drum Major at west gate at 3:20) We need to leave IMMEDIATELY after award to make it to Brandon in time to stay on schedule. We will leave awards early after our class is announced.

4:15pm – Arrive at Brandon MS, use bathroom, dress into full uniform (Gates open at 5:45pm for public)

5:00pm – Basics and warmup

5:45pm – March to stadium

6:15pm - Pipestone Marching Arrows perform "Luminous" at Big Sioux Review in Class A

6:30pm – March back to bus, change into street clothes and walk to annual Taco Johns trip.

9:00pm – Walk back to stadium and watch Class AAA field shows

10:30pm – Awards

10:45pm – Depart for Pipestone HS

11:45pm – Arrive at PAS, unload and go home!
